VISA TO ETHIOPIA

In addition to your valid passport (at least six months of validity), visas are required for all conference delegates travelling to Ethiopia. Holders of diplomatic, service, AU, UN and ADB passports and Kenyan and Djiboutian citizens will not require visas to enter Ethiopia.

Business Visas

Visas can be issued in advance from countries with Ethiopian Diplomatic Missions, Embassies or Consulates. Please note that you MUST notify epospea@gmail.com or epospeajossy@gmail.com and send a scanned copy of your passport with the picture page. You MUST also need to send a copy of your resident/work permit if you are not a national of the country in which you reside in.

We will then get the permit required to obtain a visa from the immigration authorities of Ethiopia in Addis Ababa and send a scanned copy of the permit to you. If there is an Ethiopian Embassy present in your country, you will have to officially apply and collect visa by presenting the Immigration authorization that will be sent to you. Where there is no Ethiopian Embassy or Mission in your country of residence, we will process Visa on Arrival at the Immigration in Addis Ababa and send you an authorization slip that the delegate must then print and show it to immigration authorities at the airport once they arrive in Addis Ababa in order to obtain a visa on arrival.

VISA ON ARRIVAL

Tourist visas can be issued on arrival at Bole International Airport for nationals and residents of the following countries without any invitation letter: Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, China, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, India, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Kuwait, Luxembourg, Mexico, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Democratic people's Republic of Korea (northern Korea), Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea (south Korea), the Russian Federation, Slovakia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom, and United States of America.

All visas on arrival, tourist or business visa, will be granted upon payment of either USD50 in CASH or MASTER CARD. No other currencies or cards will be accepted.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

To enter Ethiopia, a yellow fever vaccination certificate is mandatory for travelers over the age of one who is coming from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission.
